Directions: Orienteering signs will be posted from downtown Hancock for those travelling from the east also from the intersection of Routes 9 and 123 for those coming from north/west.

Maps and Terrain: 1:10,000 for Green, Red, Blue courses (+F18A Brown), 1:7500 for White, Yellow, Orange and Brown courses, 5 meter contours. IOF standard. LIDAR flown Fall 2013. Field Check and Drafting: Marcello Pradel 2014. Harris Center offers plentiful boulders, many over 4 meters high! If you enjoy Pawtuckaway, you may be delighted to know that Harris Center has even more intricate rock detail! Vegetation varying from mixed open woods to thicker undergrowth.

Courses and Awards: All USOF courses offered, including M-10A/F-10A where "shadowing" children is permitted. Awards to the top three in each age class, and first place in Open classes.
