

Beaver Brook BYOM Orienteering Instructions

Bring Your Own Map (BYOM) courses are available by downloading and printing the course maps. Participants then bring their map to Beaver Brook in Hollis, NH and locate the course markers.

Courses Offered:

White (Beginner) 1.3Km

Yellow (Advance Beginner) 1.9 Km

Orange (Intermediate) 3.3 Km

Brown (Advanced) 2.8 Km

Green (Advanced) 3.9 Km

Red (Advanced) 5.0 Km

White, Yellow, and Orange courses use plastic 4x4 inch red and white orienteering markers which are part of the Beaver Brook Association Permanent Course. Brown, Green, and Red courses use regular orange and white orienteering flags. The plastic markers and orienteering flags are numbered to confirm their location. White, Yellow, and Orange maps are 1:7,500 scale. Brown, Green, and Red are 1:10,000.

Courses start and finish at the information kiosk at the end of the Maple Hill Barn parking lot on Ridge Road in Hollis, NH. Using Google Maps Maple Hill Barn can be found as "Beaver Brook Association Ridge Road Hollis, NH." If you are going out by yourself please let someone know when you are in the woods and back out. Please practice social distancing. If the parking area looks full there is additional parking across Ridge Road from Maple Hill Barn. Hunting is not allowed on Beaver Brook property.

Bring Your Own Map (BYOM) courses will be open from November 14th through December 6, 2020.

Map Notes: water features are dry, dry leaves underfoot are slippery, and the western most portion of the map, used by Green and Red was logged several years ago and the vegetation has not been updated.
